#### WE CAN changes lives through Mentoring.

**PathMakers**, WE CAN's signature mentoring program, focuses on setting and achieving goals, mutual learning and support over a 10 month period. Monthly workshops and individual 1:1 sessions between **PathMakers** and their Partners are essential to the program's success.

#### WE CAN changes lives through Workshops, Seminars and Support:

As needs are expressed to us through the women in our programs and our referral lines, we respond with workshops, tailored training sessions and support groups. We also offer short term, 1:1 help through scheduled Financial Empowerment and Work Support sessions. A divorce support group is a regular offering along with the "From Surviving to Thriving" workshop series.

#### WE CAN changes lives through Legal Services.

Through the generosity of Cape attorneys who donate their time, WE CAN offers low/moderate income women individual 30 minute consultations on family law; wills and estates; landlord-tenant problems; bankruptcy; employment and other concerns. A "Family Law Overview Workshop" and a "Divorce Boot Camp", are regularly offered by Attorneys with expertise in family law.

#### WE CAN changes lives through Information and Referral.

Rather than duplicating services, WE CAN provides information about and referrals to a broad range of other Cape Cod organizations. Through our referral network, we help to identify resources for housing, transportation, child care, legal advice and more.
